

- Championships (a formal letter from the concerned entity has to be presented beforehand).




Attendance



Cambridge Checkpoint Exam

Checkpoint Exam is divided into two papers: each paper takes 70 minutes to answer

Paper One includes:

Comprehension (nonfiction) 20 marks

Summary5 marks

Writing (nonfiction) 25 works

Paper Two includes:

Comprehension (fiction)25 marks

Writing (fiction) 25 marks



Year Seven

Paper one will be totally covered in year 7

- Comprehension,
- Summary,
- Writing.

In addition to:

Paper 2 comprehension



Comprehension

Teach students how to read and analyze the comprehension passages from different aspects.
